All US Promoter sanction fees, must be paid by check, Paypal or credit/debit card (if acceptable) for the total amount of all fees upon mutual agreement of an NBL (re)sanction. These sanction fees must be paid, and Promoters Agreement signed, before the sanction is considered confirmed and before any advertising or tournament listings can be placed in any media source as a sanctioned event. All USA and Canadian Promoters must be willing to resanction within thirty (30) days after their tournament or penalty fees will apply (See SECTION A, III, F).
